- LAN Ports:** For wired devices, select a router with at least four Ethernet LAN ports. Some premium models offer 10G LAN/WAN ports and LAN aggregation for faster wired connections.
- Coverage and Features:** Consider the size of your home or office. Routers with dual or tri-band support, MU-MIMO, and beamforming technology ensure stable connections across multiple devices.

- Install the ONT:** Place the Optical Network Terminal near your fiber entry point. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT.
- Link ONT to Router:** Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT's Ethernet port to your router's WAN port.
- Power and Configure:** Turn on the ONT and router. Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (e.g., 192.168.1.1) and enter ISP credential...
