

How to connect fiber optic cables to a house

Step 3: Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) The ONT converts the fiber signal into data your devices can use. Place the ONT near a dedicated power source and close to your router or network equipment for efficient distribution. Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet or external termination box to the ONT's fiber port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2–5 minutes).

Step 4: Internal Fiber Routing (Optional) If relocating the ONT or extending fiber internally, plan the shortest, straightest path to minimize bends and stress on the fiber. Use pre-terminated single-mode fiber cables with SC/APC or LC connectors to simplify installation. Protect cables in low-voltage conduit in high-traffic areas and secure with soft Velcro ties to avoid crushing the cable. Avoid sharp edges, heat sources, or uninsulated attic spaces to prevent signal degradation.

Step 5: Connect the ONT to Your Router Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router...
