

How to connect fiber optic cables to a steel tower

Brackets and Hooks Use fiber optic pole brackets or hooks made of steel or aluminum alloy to provide stable support (). Attach brackets with bolts or clamps to create fixed anchor points. Curved hooks can help organize cables neatly and maintain clearance from other infrastructure. Final Steps After pulling and securing the cable, remove the installation tube, pulling sock, and protective films (). Clean fiber optic connectors and attach them to the corresponding adapters. Inspect the installation to ensure cables are properly supported, free from twists, and protected...
