- Inspect and clean connectors:** Use fiber cleaning tools to remove dust or debris, which can cause signal loss.
- Check fiber type and polish:** Ensure both ends are compatible in mode and polish type.
- Insert connectors:** Plug the large connector into the adapter or hybrid cord, then connect the smaller end to the device port. Ensure a secure click.
- Test the connection:** Use an optical power meter or network tester to verify signal integrity and minimal loss.

Additional Tips Avoid bending the fiber beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent damage. For permanent links, consider fusion splicing with pigtails if hybrid...
