

How to connect the fiber optic box panel

Step 1: Install the Fiber Optic Distribution Box Begin by mounting the fiber optic distribution box on a rack or wall. Typically, pre-terminated branch fiber jumpers or pigtails are used. Make sure the cable length inside the box is sufficient so that the front panel can be fully extended without putting tension on the fibers.

Step 3: Route and Secure Fiber Cables Inside the box, organize the fiber cables along the designated paths. Use cable ties to fix the cables at necessary points, ensuring they are not bent beyond their minimum bend radius. Avoid pulling, crushing, or sharply bending the fibers, as they are fragile and can be easily damaged.

Step 4: Connect to the Adapter Panel Connect each pre-terminated fiber optic cable to the corresponding port on the adapter panel, ensuring a one-to-one match. Secure the adapter panel to the front panel of the distribution box using bend radius control clips. This step ensures proper alignment and prevents signal loss due to excessive bending.

Step 5: Connect to the ONT and Router Once the fiber is terminated in the distribution box, connect the fiber from the box to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP. The ONT converts the light signals into electrical signals. Then, use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to your router or gateway. Power on the ONT and router, and wait for the status lights to stabilize, confirming a successful connection.
