

How to connect the fiber optic cable to the router at home

Place the router in a central, elevated location to maximize Wi-Fi coverage. Keep both ONT and router near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area. Avoid heat, moisture, and obstructions.

Step 5: Configure Router Settings

Access the router's interface via its IP address (usually 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for VoIP or video calls. Test the connection to ensure full speed and stability.

Tips for Optimal Performance

Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply; it is delicate and can degrade signal. Keep connectors clean and free of dust; use protective caps when not connected. For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems to extend coverage.
