

How to connect the optical port to an optical switch

Optical switches like the OPS-Series support both simplex and duplex connections and can be controlled via RS232 or Ethernet interfaces. Most SFP connections are plug-and-play, requiring no special configuration for standard gigabit links. Confirm that the switch and module support the desired data rate (e.g., 1G, 10G, 25G) and that all components are consistent in mode (single or multimode) to avoid signal loss.

Step 5: Test the Connection
Check the LED indicators on the switch to confirm the link is active. Use network monitoring tools or the switch GUI to verify that the optical port is transmitting and receiving data correctly. By following these steps, you can succes...
