

How to connect the router cable management bracket

To install a router cable management bracket, attach it to the designated chassis grounding points, secure it with screws, and route your cables through the bracket for organized management.

Tighten screws using a flat-head or Phillips screwdriver to the recommended torque (e.g., 13.3 inch-pounds for M4 screws on Cisco 8010 series).
- 4. Route and Secure Cables**
Pass all interface cables through the bracket in an organized manner. Use tie wraps or Velcro straps to secure cables to the bracket flanges, preventing tangling and strain on connectors. Ensure cables are not pinched or bent sharply to maintain signal integrity.
- 5. Final Checks**
Verify the bracket is firmly attached and aligned with the chassis. Confirm that all cables are properly routed and secured. If installing in a rack, lift the router into position and attach the rack-mount screws to secure the chassis.
- 6. Optional Components**
If your router includes air filters, install them after the cable management bracket, aligning with the bracket rails. Ensure g...
