Home Termination A small box called a Network Interface Device (NID) is installed outside your home to house the fiber coil. The fiber is then connected to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals into electrical signals usable by your router. Router and Wi-Fi Setup The ONT is connected to your router or gateway via an Ethernet cable. For larger homes, mesh Wi-Fi devices may be added to ensure full coverage.
