

# How to ground a 24-core fiber optic cable



## AI Overview

Grounding a 24-core fiber optic cable is only necessary if the cable contains metallic components, such as armor or strength members, and involves bonding these elements to the building's grounding system according to NEC and industry standards.

**Determine Cable Type** First, check whether your 24-core fiber optic cable contains any metallic components. Fully dielectric cables with no metal content do not require grounding because the fiber itself carries no electrical current. Metallic elements may include steel or aluminum armor, copper strength members, or metallic messenger wires. Review the cable datasheet or jacket markings to confirm the presence of metal.

**Identify Grounding Points** Select grounding points as close as possible to the equipment end or building entry. The grounding location should be stable, dry, and non-corrosive to ensure a low-impedance, reliable connection. If multiple cables are installed, each metallic component should be grounded independently to avoid closed loops.

**Prepare the Cable** Expose the metallic component: Strip back 6–8 inches of the outer jacket using a cable splitter or ringing tool to reveal armor or strength members. Clean the bonding surface: Remove oxidation or coatings with a wire brush or fine sandpaper to ensure a clean, low-resistance contact.

**Attach Grounding Hardware** Install a bonding clamp or grounding clip: Use a UL-listed clamp or manufacturer-supplied grounding kit to secure the metallic element. Connect the grounding conductor: Run a copper grounding wire from the clamp to the building's grounding electrode or main grounding bus. NEC allows a minimum of 14 AWG, but 6 AWG is preferred for both bonding and grounding purposes. Keep the conductor as short and straight as possible, generally under 20 feet, to minimize impedance.

**Verify Compliance** Ensure that the grounding installation complies with NEC Article 770, NFPA 70, and ANSI/TIA/EIA standards. The metallic components must maintain continuity and be bonded to the building's grounding sy...
