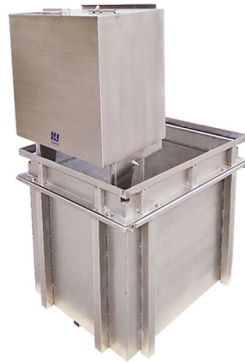

3. Ensure Low Ground Resistance
The total resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm. If multiple devices or long cables are involved, calculate parallel resistances to confirm the total remains below the safe threshold.
4. Bond All Conductive Parts
All phases of the power lines and any conductive objects within reach should be bonded together to create an equipotential zone. Single-phase grounding of multi-phase circuits is prohibited to prevent unsafe voltage differences.
5. Use Proper Grounding Materials
Copper or copper-clad steel conductors are preferred for durability and conductivity. Avoid substandard materials that may corrode quickly and compromise safety.
6. Test the Grounding System
Measure the resistance of the grounding system after installation. If resistance exceeds 25 Ohms, install additional rods or conductors to reduce it. Regular testing ensures continued safety and system stability.

Only qualified electricians should perform grounding work. Ensure that the grounding path can safely carry fault currents to prevent elec...
