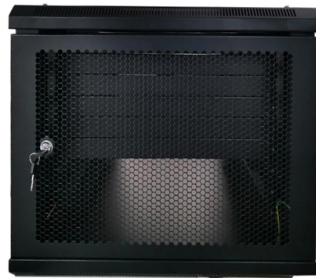


How to identify gigabit fiber optic cables

Multimode Fiber (MMF) Multimode fiber cables have a larger core (50 μm or 62.5 μm) that allows multiple light paths, making them suitable for short-distance communication, such as within LANs, data centers, or campus networks. Common subtypes include:

- OM1:** 62.5 μm core, supports 10 Gbps up to 300 meters.
- OM2:** 50 μm core, supports 10 Gbps up to 550 meters.
- OM3:** 50 μm core, supports 10 Gbps up to 1000 meters and 40 Gbps up to 400 meters.
- OM4:** Enhanced 50 μm core, supports 10 Gbps up to 1100 meters and 40/100 Gbps up to 150–400 meters.
- OM5:** Optimized for shortwave wavelength division multiplexing (SWDM), allowing multiple wavelengths over the same fiber for higher capacity and flexibility.

- Tight-Buffered:** Fiber is coated tightly, ideal for indoor installations and shorter distances.
- Loose-Tube:** Fiber is laid in a spiral within semi-rigid tubes, suitable for outdoor and long-distance applications, providing flexibility and protection against environmental stress.
