

How to install a heat shrink joint box

Step 4: Shrink the Sleeves Apply heat circumferentially from the middle outwards to shrink the inner sleeves first, allowing the sealant to melt and the sleeve to achieve uniform wall thickness (). Press the cores together to form a compact joint. Position the outer heat shrink sleeve over the joint, ensuring equal overlap on both sides, and shrink it using the same method (). Avoid overheating to prevent damage to the sleeves or cable insulation.

Step 5: Final Checks Allow the joint to cool completely before applying any mechanical strain (). Inspect the joint for uniform recovery, proper adhesion, and absence of gaps or air...
