

# How to install network cables on a fiber optic router

The WAN port is usually labeled and may be colored differently from other ports. Ensure the router is compatible with fiber connections; some routers require an SFP or fiber-ready port.

**Step 4: Power Up and Verify** Plug in the ONT first and wait for it to boot and register with the ISP network. Status lights indicate connection health: a solid green Power light and a solid green or blue Optical/PON light confirm a successful link. After the ONT is stable, power on the router and wait for its indicator lights to confirm connectivity.

**Step 5: Test the Connection** Connect a device via Wi-Fi or Ethernet to the router. Run a speed test to verify that the fiber connection is active and performing as expected.

**Precautions** Keep the fiber cable straight and avoid sharp bends to prevent signal loss.
