

How to interconnect core switches and PoE switches

Core switches should connect to PoE switches using dedicated uplink or standard ports, following a star topology with optional link aggregation for redundancy and bandwidth optimization.

Port Selection

Uplink Ports: If the PoE switch has a designated uplink port, use it to connect to the core switch. This port is optimized for inter-switch communication and may support higher speeds ().

Standard Ports: If no uplink port is available, any standard port can be used, but ensure that the cable type and length meet Ethernet standards (straight-through cables for uplink connections, max 100 meters for twisted pair) ().

PoE Ports: Avoid using PoE ports for interconnecting switches unless the switch supports standard PoE chipsets that can safely detect powered devices. Connecting a PoE port to a non-PoE device can damage equipment ().

Cabling

Ethernet Cables: Use high-quality Cat5e or Cat6 cables for short distances. For longer distances or higher bandwidth requirements, consider fiber optic connections with pre-terminated LC connectors to reduce signal loss ().

Link Aggregation: If multiple ports are available, consider link aggregation (LACP) between the core and PoE switches. This provides redundancy and doubles the maximum throughput, though a single data stream is still limited to the speed of one port ().

Cascading: Connect PoE switches to the core switch in a cascade if extending the network, but limit the number of cascaded layers (typica...
