For example, alternative labeling systems such as NFPA diamonds, HMIS color codes, or simplified pictograms are allowed if employees are trained to understand them. Immediate-use containers may be exempt from labeling if used promptly by the employee who filled them. Practical Considerations for Secondary Distribution Boxes Durability and readability: Labels must remain legible under normal handling, storage, and environmental conditions. This includes resistance to moisture, abrasion, and chemical exposure. Traceability: For industrial or food/beverage secondary packaging, barcodes or other identifiers should be applied to maintain product tracking and verification throughout the supply chain. Training: Employees must be trained to interpret the labels or alternative systems to ensure safe handling...
