

How to lay fiber optic cables for internet access

Termination and Testing Once the cable is laid, terminate it at the optical network terminal (ONT) or distribution point . Perform testing for insertion loss, return loss, and OTDR verification to ensure signal integrity . Proper testing prevents future connectivity issues and ensures high-speed performance.
