

How to place optical cables on an optical fiber reel

To insert an optical cable into a fiber optic reel, connect the cable to the drum exit port, align it with the exit cover slots, secure it to the tie-down block, and wind it carefully using the crank or spring rewind mechanism.

- 4. Wind the Cable onto the Reel** Insert the crank handle into the side of the reel and wind the cable evenly onto the drum. For spring rewind reels, unlock the drum, rotate it in the rewind direction, and wind the cable carefully, following directional arrows to avoid spring damage. Do not exceed the recommended number of rotations ().
- 5. Maintain Proper Handling** Avoid sharp bends or twisting; respect the cable's minimum bend radius. Use figure-8 loops when laying the cable on the ground to prevent twisting. Keep the cable protected from mechanical stress, UV exposure, and extreme temperatures during installation ().
- 6. Final Checks** Ensure the cable is seated properly in the exit port and tie-down block. Verify that the reel rotates smoothly and that the cable winds evenly without overlapping or cross-winding. Stow the crank ha...
