Lightweight or frequently accessed devices at the top: This improves accessibility and reduces strain during maintenance. Airflow and Cooling Front-to-back airflow: Align servers so cold air enters the front and hot air exits the back. Use blanking panels: Fill empty rack spaces with panels to prevent hot air recirculation and maintain consistent cooling. Maintain clearance: Leave sufficient space around racks for engineers and airflow, and integrate fans or air conditioning as needed. Cable Management Organize cables vertically and horizontally: Use Velcro ties, cable trays, and horizontal/vertical managers to prevent tangling and improve airflow. Label all connections: Clearly mark cables for easy identification during maintenance or upgrades. Separate power and data cables: This reduces interference and simplifies troubleshooting.
