

How to properly install a temporary power distribution box

- Receptacles:** Include 15A and 20A 120V outlets, and optionally 30A or 50A 240V outlets for larger equipment.

Step 3: Mounting and Grounding

- Position** the box at an accessible height and secure it to a stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Install grounding rods and connect them to the box to protect against surges or faults.
- Ensure all wiring is insulated, properly routed, and free from exposed conductors.

Step 4: Wiring the Box

- Feed** the main power cable through a bushing or strain relief to prevent damage.
- Connect the hot, neutral, and ground wires to the main bus bar or lugs.
- Wire each branch circuit to its respective breaker and receptacle, following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Label each outlet and breaker for easy identification and troubleshooting.

Step 5: Testing and Operation

- Turn on the main breaker and test each GFCI module by pressing the TEST button to ensure proper operation.
