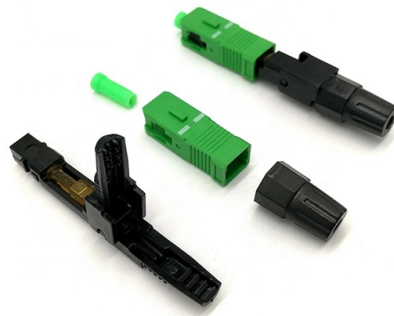


# How to quickly remove the fibroid



## AI Overview

Fibroids can be managed with medications, minimally invasive procedures, or surgical removal, depending on size, location, symptoms, and fertility goals.

**Medication Options**

Medications can help shrink fibroids or reduce symptoms such as heavy bleeding and pelvic pressure. Common options include:

- Hormonal contraceptives or progestational agents:** Regulate menstrual cycles and reduce bleeding but do not shrink fibroids. Side effects may include nausea, headaches, breast tenderness, and mood changes.
- Gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH) agonists:** Temporarily induce a menopause-like state to shrink fibroids and improve anemia. Often used short-term before surgery due to potential bone loss with long-term use.
- Hormonal intrauterine devices (IUDs):** Reduce heavy bleeding but do not remove fibroids.

**Surgical Options**

Surgery is considered when fibroids cause significant symptoms or fertility issues. The main procedures include:

- Myomectomy:** Removes fibroids while preserving the uterus, ideal for women who wish to conceive. Methods vary:
  - Hysteroscopic myomectomy:** Fibroids removed through the vagina; suitable for submucosal fibroids. Recovery is 1–4 days.
  - Laparoscopic myomectomy:** Small abdominal incisions; hospital stay of one night, recovery 2–4 weeks.
  - Abdominal myomectomy:** Open surgery for larger or multiple fibroids; hospital stay 2 nights, recovery 4–6 weeks.
- Hysterectomy:** Complete removal of the uterus, eliminating fibroids permanently. Recommended for women who do not plan future pregnancies.

**Minimally Invasive and Non-Surgical Procedures**

- Uterine artery embolization (UAE):** Injects particles to block blood flow to fibroids, causing them to shrink. Suitable for women who want to avoid surgery and do not plan to become pregnant.
- MRI-guided focused ultrasound (FUS):** Noninvasive procedure using ultrasound energy to destroy fibroids while preserving the uterus.
- Myolysis:** Laparoscopic procedure using electric current or freezing to destroy fibroids and shrink blood vessels supplying them.
