

How to remove fiber optic cable bundle tubes

5. Remove Buffer or Loose TubesSlide the severed section of the buffer tube off the fibers. For gel-filled tubes, clean the gel using appropriate wipes or solvents (). Ensure the fibers remain untangled and strain-free.
6. Strip Fiber CoatingsFor individual fibers or bundles, use a mechanical fiber stripper or a thermal fiber stripper. Thermal strippers apply controlled heat to soften the coating, allowing clean removal without micro-cracks (). Insert the fiber into the clamping system, activate the heating mechanism, and gently pull the coating off.
7. Final PreparationTrim any remaining tube shavings or coating residues. Organize the fibers for splicing or termination, ensuring proper strain relief and alignment.
