Step 5: Address Splices and Connectors Examine fusion or mechanical splices for excessive loss. Poor field fusion or mechanical splices can degrade performance. Replace or repair faulty splices using a skilled operator or splice cart. Ensure all connectors follow proper fiber type color coding to avoid mismatches.
