- Internal Wiring Arrangement** Arrange wires neatly and tie them into bundles using nylon tape or similar fasteners. Maintain proper electrical clearance and creepage distances according to standards like GB7251 or IEC requirements. Use black wires for secondary wiring and consider layered trunking for organized distribution.
- Inspection and Testing** Inspect the box for deformations, paint loss, and completeness of instruments before energizing. Conduct continuity and insulation r...
