

How to set up a fiber optic fusion splicer for single mode

Fiber Preparation Strip the fiber coating carefully to expose the glass core without nicking it. Clean the bare fiber with alcohol-soaked lint-free wipes, wiping from the coating edge to the cleave tip in a single stroke. Cleave the fiber at a precise 90° angle using a high-quality cleaver. Inspect the cleave under a microscope or the splicer's built-in camera to ensure smooth, flat end faces.

Splicer Setup and Alignment Power on the fusion splicer and allow it to warm up if required. Select the appropriate fiber type in the splicer menu to match your single-mode fiber. Insert the fibers into the splicer's fiber holders, ensuring they are properly seated. The splicer will automatically align the fiber cores using its imaging system. Core alignment is critical for single-mode fibers due to their small mode-field diameter.
