

How to stack optical cables

Proper optical cable stacking requires careful handling, secure storage, and adherence to bend radius, tension, and environmental protection standards to prevent damage and maintain performance.

Cable Storage and Stacking

Reel Placement: Store reels on flat, firm surfaces to prevent flanges from sinking or shifting. Avoid laying reels on their sides, as this can cause cable layers to shift and snag during de-reeling (Belden).

Securing Reels: Use appropriate devices to prevent reel movement during storage. Ensure cable ends are sealed with heat-shrink caps to prevent moisture intrusion.

Environmental Protection: Avoid storage in areas prone to flooding, sharp rocks, or uneven terrain. Maintain protective material on the cable until installation to prevent mechanical damage.

Temperature Considerations: Respect the maximum storage temperature specified in the cable datasheet, as exceeding it can damage the cable sheath.

Handling During Installation

Bend Radius: Maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to prevent microbending or macrobending losses.

Tension Limits: Limit pulling tension according to cable type; for outside plant cables, a maximum of 600 lbs is typical, with proper calibration of pullers and capstans.

Figure-8 Loops: When laying cable on a surface, use figure-8 loops to prevent twisting and maintain cable integrity. Loop size typically ranges from 2 to 4 meters depending on cable stiffness.

Avoid Sharp Edges: Do not pull cables over edges or sharp objects. Minimize mechanical pressure at crossing points, especially for armored cables.

Reel and Payoff Management

Back-Tension Control: Maintain consistent back-tension during payoff to prevent cable squirting, tangling, or kinking. Secure the top layer of cable on the reel to avoid slack.

Reel Inspection: Inspect reels for damage before de-reeling. Hand-tighten flange bolts periodically to maintain reel stability.

Movement of Reels: Move heavy reels upright using forklifts or reel movers; do not roll reels against the indicated roll direction. S...
