

How to thread fiber optic cables through a panel

Step 4: Install Connectors Attach the appropriate connector to each fiber using a connector installation tool or epoxy kit. Ensure the fiber core is centered and properly aligned within the ferrule. Common connector types include LC, SC, and ST, chosen based on compatibility with the patch panel.

Step 5: Thread the Fiber Through the Panel Route the fiber through the patch panel openings, maintaining a minimum bend radius (typically 1.5–2 inches for individual fibers and 5 inches for cable loops) to prevent signal loss or damage. Avoid running fibers through brackets or tight spaces that could shear the cable. Place home run fibers in the bottom portion of horizontal plates or on the left side o...
