Maintain proper bend radius and avoid tight bundling, especially with high-power PoE++ or fiber cables .Use color-coded cables to simplify identification and troubleshooting .Label and Document: Label both ends of each cable with unique identifiers. Maintain documentation of port connections to reduce Mean Time To Repair (MTTR) and simplify future upgrades .Maintain Airflow and Accessibility: Avoid overloading cable trays or managers to prevent crushed cab...
