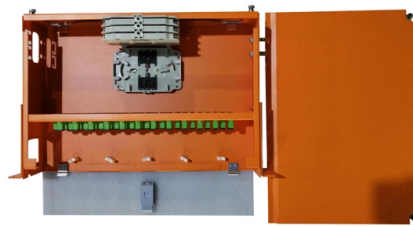


How to use the optical module jumper cable

Avoid bending the fiber excessively; maintain a minimum bend radius of 400 mm to prevent signal loss.
4. Protect and Secure the Fiber Route the fiber jumper neatly through cable management trays or slots. Coil any excess fiber and secure it with bundling tape or protective sleeves to prevent damage. Ensure the fiber is not twisted, crossed, or hanging outside the rack.
5. Test the Connection Use fiber optic testing equipment to verify signal quality and stability. Confirm that the transmit and receive wavelengths of the connected optical modules match. If disconnection is needed, press the clip or latch first, then remove the fiber jumper. When removing the optical module, pull it out by the handle and wait at least 0.2 seconds before reinserting.
