

Hungarian Cable Tray Connection Plate Installation

Install cable tray connection plates by aligning trays, using appropriate fasteners, and ensuring proper support spacing and grounding.

Step-by-Step Installation

1. Plan the Route and Layout Before installation, mark the cable tray route according to your electrical design and site layout. Ensure adequate clearance from walls, ceilings, and other systems, leaving at least 300 mm above or between installed systems for cable access and maintenance (). Consider future cable additions when planning support locations.
2. Select the Correct Tray and Connection Plate Choose the cable tray type (ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom) based on load, airflow, and cable type. Connection plates are used to join trays in straight or angled configurations. For widths of 400 mm or more, a joint plate is required to prevent transverse bending ().
3. Prepare Supports Install supports such as trapeze hangers, wall brackets, or ceiling mounts. Vertical hangers should be positioned accurately, and cross members should be level. Drill or punch holes slightly larger than the threaded rods to allow adjustment (). Supports are typically spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load ().
4. Align and Connect Trays Insert the straight connector into the inside of the tray rail. Clamp the joint plate between the connectors and fasten using FRS M6 truss-head bolts and combination nuts. Ensure the trays are level and allow for minor horizontal adjustments (). Angle connectors can be used for horizontal bends or corners. Adjustable connectors accommodate rises or drops.
5. Secure and Ground Tighten all fasteners carefully to avoid damaging the tray or cables. Ensure electrical continuity every 18 meters by bonding trays to the building structure (). Protective gloves should be worn to prevent injury from sharp edges ().
6. Lay and Organize Cables Once trays are installed, lay cables neatly using cable ties or strap...
