- Meter socket:** Standardized receptacle for the electricity meter.

Meter boxes ensure accurate energy measurement for billing and monitoring, and they comply with utility regulations and national electrical codes. Common meter types include single-phase 220V or 120/240V meters, with rated currents typically $\geq 63A$ for residential applications. Modern meters may also include DIN rail-mounted energy meters for multi-circuit monitoring.

Distribution Box Overview

A distribution box (or distribution board) receives power from the meter and distributes it to multiple branch circuits within a building. Key features include:

- Protective devices:** MCBs, RCCBs, RCBOs to prevent overloads, short circuits, and leakage currents.
- Busbars and terminals:** Shrouded for safety, allowing secure connections.
- Modular design:** Supports flexible configuration of incoming devices and outgoing circuits.
- Installation location:** Usually indoors, in service rooms or accessible areas for maintenance.

Distribution boxes are available in various sizes and configurations, such as ABB Mini Center Compact boards, which allow for multiple incomers and modular components. They are made from metal or flame-retardant plastic, often CE-certified, and include standard 35mm rails for mounting breakers. I...
