Single-Fiber (BiDi) Module Considerations

Single-fiber modules, also known as BiDi (Bidirectional) SFPs, transmit and receive on a single fiber using different wavelengths for each direction. Correct operation requires proper wavelength matching between the Tx and Rx ports. LED indicators behave similarly to dual-fiber modules, lighting up only when the connection is properly established.

Troubleshooting Using LEDs

If the LED does not light up after inserting the module, it may indicate that the fiber is not connected, the wavelengths are mismatched, or the link is not established. Use the triangles on the SFP module to identify Tx (transmit) and Rx (receive) ports; the LED will only indicate activity when the fiber is correctly connected to the corresponding port. Fiber testers like FiberLert™ or power meters can verify that light is being transmitted and received, helping isolate whether the issue is with the module or the fiber cable.
