Network Layer-Based Switches

- Layer 4 Switches:** Manage traffic based on transport layer ports (TCP/UDP), enabling fine-grained control for critical applications like SCADA systems.

Physical Interface Types

- Copper Ethernet (RJ45):** Uses twisted-pair cables for short-distance communication, supporting speeds from 10 Mbps to 10 Gbps. Cost-effective and easy to deploy.
- Fiber Optic Interfaces:** Designed for long-distance, high-speed communication with EMI immunity. Common connectors include LC, SC, ST, FC, SFP, and SFP+ modules, supporting single-mode and multi-mode fibers.
- Serial Interfaces (RS-232, RS-485, RS-422):** Enable legacy device connectivity. RS-232 is for point-to-point, while RS-485/RS-422 support multi-point communication, often used in PLC and SCADA systems.
- CANbus Interfaces:** Facilitate direct device-to-device communication in automation systems, commonly used in automotive and robotics applications.
- Terminal Blocks:** Provide secure connections for power supply or serial wiring in harsh industrial environments.
- PoE Ports:** Deliver both power and data over the same cable, simplifying wiring for devices like IP cameras and sensors.
- Combo Ports:** Combine RJ45 and SFP interfaces, allowing flexible choice between copper and fiber connections.

- Push-Button Switches:** Activated by pressing, used for emergency stops or process control. Available in momentary or maintained operation.
