Style 6 (Class A): Modules are wired in series with the addressable device circuit, forming a continuous loop (). Device Limits: Do not install more than 20 devices per module or more than 15 modules per addressable device circuit. Ensure total wire resistance does not exceed 20 ohms (). Compliance: All wiring must comply with national and local electrical codes. Use proper conduit and secure wiring to prevent damage. Testing: After installation, restore power and test the module and connected devices to ensure proper operation. Verify that alarms, LEDs, and comm...
