Ensure trays are aligned, level, and securely connected using appropriate fittings. For long runs, consider using cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable laying and prevent kinks ().

Cable Laying and Organization Lay cables neatly within the trays, separating them by voltage, function, or type. Use cable ties or straps to maintain organization and leave sufficient slack for thermal expansion or future adjustments (). Avoid overfilling trays to maintain airflow and prevent overheating.

Grounding and Bonding Metal trays must be properly grounded and bonded to ensure electrical safety. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections to mai...
