

Installation of circuit breaker strip in distribution box

- Grounding:** Connect all grounding wires to the earth bar. Ensure the metal enclosure is properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards.
- Labeling:** Clearly label each breaker for its corresponding circuit to facilitate maintenance and troubleshooting.
