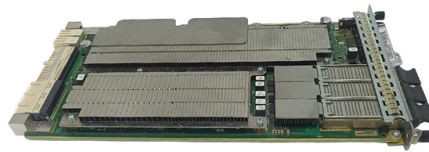


Installation of distribution boxes and sockets

Planning and Preparation Before installation, determine the load requirements for each socket circuit and select the appropriate Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) or fuses for protection. Ensure the distribution box is rated for the total anticipated load and is installed in a dry, accessible, and ventilated location at an appropriate height (around 1.5 meters) with proper IP/NEMA ratings for protection.

Wiring the Socket Circuits

Wire Selection: Use 2.5mm² wires for standard socket circuits. For higher-load appliances, 4mm² wires may be required.

Connection Method: Connect each socket circuit wire to the incoming terminal of its respective MCB. Parallel connections can be used to simplify wiring, but ensure each connection is secure.

Wiring Direction: Typically, wiring from the main circuit breaker to branch breakers is routed on the left side of the box, and wiring exiting the box to sockets is routed on the right.

Binding and Organization: Use plastic ties to keep wires straight and organized, maintaining uniform spacing to prevent tangling or stress on connections.

Safety Measures

Grounding: Ensure all socket circuits are properly grounded to prevent electric shock.

Insulation and Testing: Perform insulation tests to check for leakage or ground faults before powering the circuits.

Protective Devices: Include RCCBs or GFCIs for circuits in wet areas like kitchens, bathrooms, or outdoor sockets to prevent electrocution.

Personal Safety: Use insulated tools, rubber-soled shoes, and gloves, and switch off the main power before working.
