

Installation of gas pipe cable trays



AI Overview

Proper installation of cable trays near gas pipes requires careful layout, adequate support, correct material selection, and strict adherence to safety distances to prevent damage and ensure operational safety.

Material Selection and Tray Type
Cable trays for gas pipe environments should be made of corrosion-resistant materials, such as hot-dip galvanized steel, stainless steel (AISI 316L), or aluminum alloys, depending on environmental conditions and exposure to corrosive gases or moisture. Ladder-type or perforated trays are preferred to allow ventilation and prevent water accumulation. Covers should be installed where there is a risk of mechanical damage or exposure to corrosive substances.

Layout and Support
Tray routing should follow the shortest, most economical path while maintaining accessibility for maintenance. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 m to 3 m, verified according to tray type and load. Ladder trays can span up to 3 m, while perforated trays should not exceed 2 m between supports. Trays should be self-supporting or fixed to steel/concrete structures using standard steel shapes or self-drilling dowels. Avoid using cable trays as walkways.

Safety Distances from Gas Pipes
Maintain a minimum distance of 500 mm when trays intersect with pipelines carrying corrosive gases or liquids. If thermal pipelines are present, the distance should be ≥ 500 mm with insulation or ≥ 1000 mm without insulation, with protective thermal boards at intersections. Protective covers or insulation boards should extend at least $d + 2000$ mm, where d is the outer diameter of the pipe or insulation. Trays should not be installed directly below corrosive pipelines or above corrosive gas lines.

Installation Procedure
Inspection and Storage: Inspect all trays and accessories for damage and store horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at 1 m intervals.

Shop Drawing Review: Verify approved layouts, lengths, and locations before installation.

Fixing: Attach trays to steel or concrete structures, ensuring proper alignment.
