

Installation of mobile room cable trays

Materials commonly used include galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum, and fiberglass, selected based on load, environment, and corrosion resistance.

Mounting and Supports Install threaded rod supports with appropriate anchors, then attach 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels using nuts. Maintain a maximum support spacing of 1.2 meters to prevent sagging. Provide additional support for bends, branches, and offsets. Cable trays can be mounted on walls, ceilings, or floors depending on the room layout. Ensure alignment, level installation, and secure connections using appropriate fittings.

Cable Laying and Safety Lay cables according to type and load, maintaining proper separation and spacing. Ground the trays as required and label all cables for identification. All operatives should attend safety induction and competency verification, and supervisors must monitor adherence to safe work practices. Follow relevant standards such as IEC 61537, NEC Article 392, and local building codes.
