

Installation of power distribution boxes in multi-story buildings



AI Overview

Power distribution boxes in multi-story buildings should be installed on each floor with proper main and sub-circuits, using appropriately rated breakers and protection devices to ensure safe and balanced electricity distribution.

General Principles In multi-story buildings, electricity can be distributed either through a separate energy meter for each floor or a single energy meter on the ground floor. The preferred method is to install a separate meter per floor, as it allows better load management, easier fault isolation, and more accurate billing for each unit or floor. Each floor typically has its own distribution board (DB), which receives power from the main distribution board (MDB). The MDB is usually located on the ground floor or basement for quick access in emergencies. From the DB, sub-circuits are drawn to supply lamps, fans, sockets, and other electrical loads.

Single-Phase vs Three-Phase Systems Single-phase distribution is common for residential floors with moderate loads. Each floor receives one phase from the main supply, and the neutral may be shared or separate depending on design. Three-phase distribution is preferred for commercial or high-load buildings. A three-phase energy meter feeds the MDB, which then distributes power to each floor's DB. Each DB can have its own MCCB (Moulded Case Circuit Breaker) as the main switch, with sub-circuits protected by MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) and RCDs (Residual Current Devices) for safety.

Installation Steps

- Plan the Wiring Layout:** Create a blueprint indicating loads, DB locations, outlets, and wiring routes. Calculate total electrical load and number of circuits per floor.
- Install Main Distribution Board (MDB):** Connect the incoming supply (single-phase or three-phase) to the MDB. Use an MCCB rated for the total load of all floors.
- Install Floor Distribution Boards:** Each floor DB receives power from the MDB. Install a main breaker in each...
