A secondary distribution box on a construction site should be installed in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, with proper grounding, IP55 protection, and correctly rated circuit breakers to ensure safe and reliable power distribution.

Site Selection and Placement The secondary distribution box should be installed below the main distribution box and close to areas with concentrated electrical loads, ensuring the distance between the main and secondary boxes does not exceed 30 meters, and the distance to the final switch boxes is within 3 meters. Choose a dry, ventilated, and normal temperature location, away from flammable, corrosive, or high-impact areas. Ensure enough space around the box for two people to work safely and avoid stacking materials or obstructing access. For outdoor setups, select a box with IP55 or higher protection to guard against dust and water jets.

Installation Height and Fixing The bottom of a fixed secondary distribution box should be 1.3–1.5 meters above the ground, while mobile boxes can be 0.6–1.5 meters. Use a firm mounting method, such as expansion bolts or brackets, to prevent tilting or movement due to vibration or impact. Ensure the box is stable and level before proceeding with wiring.

Wiring and Electrical Connections Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load. All wires should be insulated, with no exposed live parts, and properly terminated on designated terminals: line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground. Separate protective neutral and working neutral connections using terminal blocks. Install circuit breakers, fuses, and earth leakage protection for each circuit to enhance safety. Route wires neatly inside the...
