Selection Considerations

Single-mode vs. Multimode: Use single-mode connectors (yellow cables) for long-distance links and multimode connectors (OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5, typically orange, aqua, or lime green) for short intra-data center connections.

Application: LC connectors are preferred for high-density SFP/SFP+ transceivers, SC for GBIC modules, ST for older patch panels, and FC for stable ODF connections.

Environmental Factors: Consider jacket type (PVC, LSZH, plenum) for fire safety and installation environment.
