For plastic enclosures, grounding is not required for the box itself, but all circuits must still be grounded.

Conduit and Sealing Use rigid or flexible conduit to protect feeder wires from the main panel to the outdoor box. Employ liquid-tight fittings, cord grips, or compression connectors with O-rings or gaskets to maintain a watertight seal at entry points. For non-metallic sheathed cable, use wet-location-rated cable connectors or glands. Seal any unused knockouts with listed plugs or se...
