

Is it okay to install a socket next to the distribution box

- Use a proper junction box:** The socket should be mounted in a securely affixed box, not directly on the panel cover.
- Wiring method:** You can connect the socket via a spur from an existing circuit or from a dedicated MCB in the consumer unit. Ensure the correct cable size (e.g., 2.5mm² twin & earth for a 16A socket) and use a suitable gland or grommet to maintain fire integrity (Screwfix community).
- Circuit protection:** If connecting directly to the consumer unit, use an appropriate MCB for the socket's load. Avoid using lighting circuits for high-power devices.
- Accessibility:** Ensure the socket does not obstruct access to the distribution box or any breakers.
