The rack includes 2 routers, 1 firewall, patch panels, switches, PBX, WAN load balancer, 2 Synology rackstations servers, 2 rack UPS, 2 PDU, NVR, and 1 ATS. The safest way to choose is not by product name alone. You should check the internal structure, rated current, number of ways, protection devices, enclosure material, and IP. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
