- Control Wiring and Relays:** The box contains wiring that connects to the elevator control panels, relays, and safety devices, ensuring proper operation of motors, doors, and emergency systems.
- Wiring Channels and Conduits:** Internal channels organize the wires, and conduits connect the box to the machine room, hoistway, and control panels. Only wiring necessary for elevator operation is permitted inside these spaces.
- Metering and Surge Protection:** Some distribution boxes include integrated meters to monitor voltage and current, as well as surge protection to safeguard sensitive electronics.

Additional Considerations

- Installation Height and Location:** Typically installed near the machine room door at 120–140 cm from the floor, secured with bolts.
