Understanding QSFP28
QSFP28 (Quad Small Form-Factor Pluggable 28) is a high-performance transceiver designed for 100 Gigabit Ethernet. It aggregates four parallel 25G electrical lanes, providing a total payload of 100 Gbps, with a physical signaling ceiling of 28 Gbps per lane to accommodate encoding overhead and error correction. Each lane can also be broken out into four discrete 25G connections if needed. QSFP28 modules are hot-swappable, meaning they can be inserted or removed without powering down the host device.

Installation Steps
Prepare the Port and Module: Ensure the QSFP28 port on your switch or optical line terminal is compatible with the module type (SR4, LR4, CWDM4, etc.) and that the device supports 100G operation.
Insert the Module: Align the QSFP28 module with the port cage and gently push until it clicks into place. The module should be fully seated to establish electrical contact.
Connect Fiber-Optic Cables: Use the correct fiber type and connector (typically MPO/MTP 8-fiber for 4 Tx + 4 Rx channels). Ensure the transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) fibers are correctly oriented to match the module on the other end.
Verify Power and Grounding: QSFP28 modules have multiple power pins (VccTX, VccRX, Vcc1) and a common ground (GND). These must be properly connected internally or via the host board to ensure stable operation.
Check Link Status: After connecting, verify that the host device recognizes the module and that the optical link is active. Many devices support Quality Identification (ID) to confirm certified module compatibility.

Pinout and Electrical Considerations
QSFP28 uses CAUI-4 electrical interface, with four differential transmit and receive pairs. Each lane operates at ~25.78125 Gbps with 64b/66b encoding. Proper grounding and power supply to the module are essential to prevent signal d...
