Neutral and Ground Separation: In subpanels or distribution boxes downstream of the main service panel, neutral and ground wires must remain separate. Jumper wires should not inadvertently bond neutral and ground except at the main panel. Proper Insulation and Clearance: Ensure jumpers do not contact other live parts or create short circuits.
