

Junction Box Opening Tool

Once the cover is loose, pull it away carefully, ensuring no wires are stressed or disconnected.

Step 5: Inspect and Work Inside After opening, inspect the box for damage, corrosion, or loose connections. If necessary, use pliers to loosen terminal screws and remove wires safely. When finished, reconnect wires securely, replace the cover, and restore power to test the circuit.

Tips Never attempt to open a box when it is wet or damp. If the box uses plastic rivets or press-fit components, avoid forcing metal screws; consider replacing the box if it...
