

Laying out finished optical cables

Properly laying out finished optical cables requires careful handling, maintaining bend radius, avoiding twists, and using protective measures to prevent damage during installation.

Preparation and Planning Before laying the cable, plan the route carefully, considering environmental factors, obstacles, and the type of installation (indoor, outdoor, aerial, or direct-buried) to ensure smooth deployment. Use figure-8 loops when laying cable on the ground to prevent twisting; typical loop sizes range from 2 to 4 meters depending on cable stiffness. Protect the cable from mechanical stress: Avoid pulling over edges, stepping on the cable, or crossing cables in a way that creates high-pressure points. Use proper pulling grips: Never pull on connectors; use swivel-equipped grips to prevent twisting and monitor tension to stay within the cable's maximum tensile load.

Laying Techniques

- Direct-buried cables:** Place a protective layer of sand or gravel below and above the cable, and use warning tape to prevent accidental digging.
- Aerial installations:** Ensure proper sag and tension to prevent breakage in high winds. Use appropriate supports and clamps to avoid crushing the cable.
- Indoor installations:** Route cables along trays or conduits, maintaining bend radius and avoiding sharp turns. LSZH sheathed cables are more sensitive to mechanical stress, especially at higher temperatures.

Splicing, Termination, and Testing Splice or terminate cables at designated points using protective closures to prevent moisture ingress. Test the installed cable with an OTDR or other optical testing equipment to verify signal integrity and document the route, depth, and location for future reference.
